Get crafty and make some jewellery to sell with family and friends.





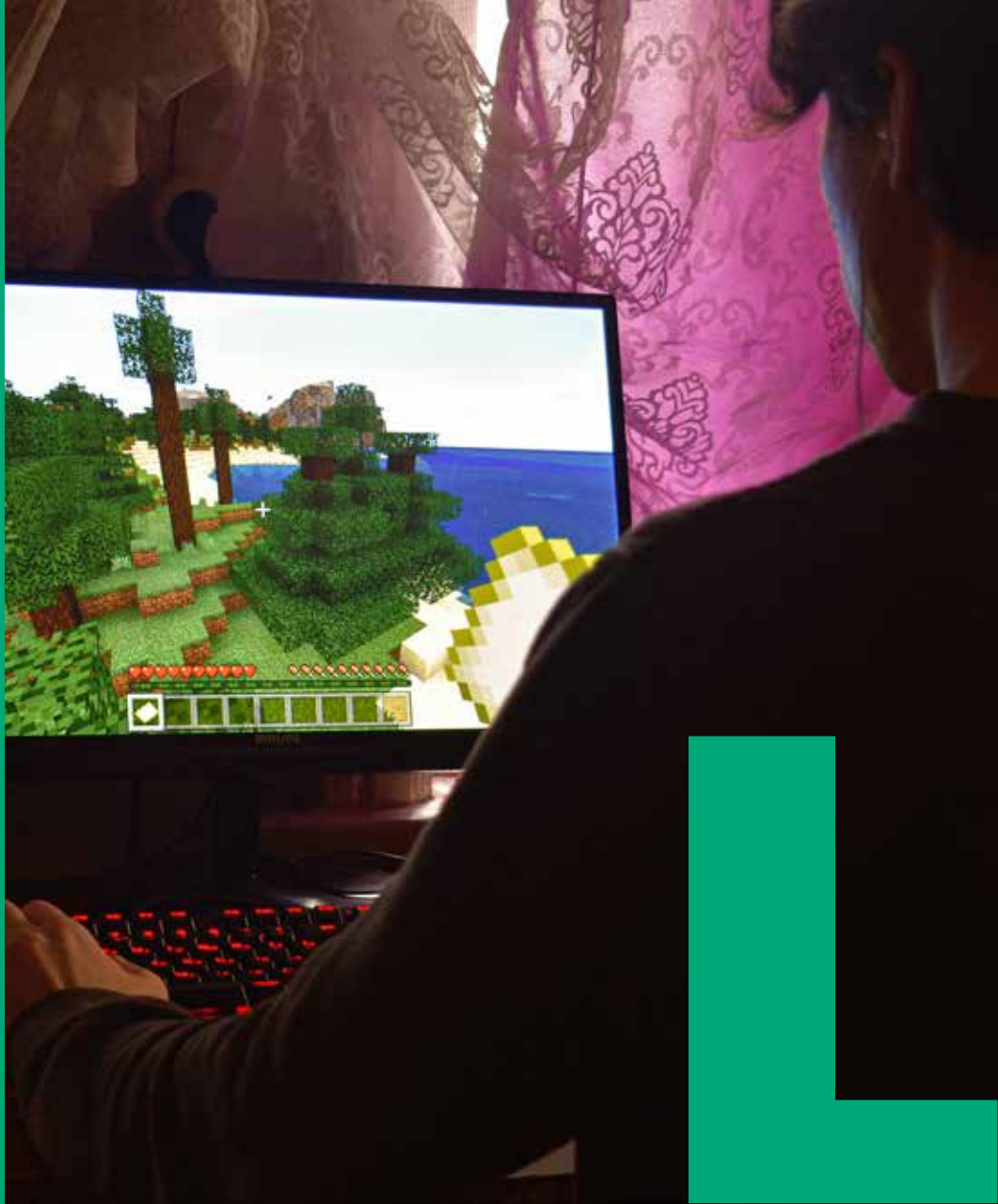
Karaoke Competition
